- Nominations must be supported by your coach, instructor or relevant sports governing body.
- Nominees must reside within the administrative boundaries of Gloucestershire or South Gloucestershire.

Nominations should be submitted by Friday 5 September 2025. The awards presentation will take place at the GPFA AGM, which will be held in November 2025.

Past winners have come from a wide range of sports and parasports including BMX, archery, athletics, squash, frame running, tennis, skiing, rowing, cricket and hockey.
